A recent study involving Kansas State University researchers 1) ___ that in the coming decades, at least one-quarter of the world's wheat production 2) ___ to extreme weather and water stress if no adaptive measures are taken.

Researchers found that the effects from climate change and its increasing temperatures on wheat will be more severe than once projected and are happening sooner than expected. While increases in the average temperature are problematic, a bigger challenge is the extreme temperatures that 3) ___ from climate change. Researchers also found that increasing temperatures are shortening the time frame that wheat plants have 4) ___ and produce full heads for harvest, resulting in less grain produced from each plant.
